COHERENT CORP. REPORTS FOURTH QUARTER AND FULL YEAR FISCAL 2026 RESULTS

- **Q4 REVENUE OF \$2.05B, INCREASED 34% Y/Y AND 42% Y/Y ON A PRO FORMA BASIS**

SAXONBURG, Pa., August 12, 2026 – Coherent Corp. (NYSE: COHR) (“Coherent,” “We,” or the “Company”), a global leader in photonics, announced financial results today for its fiscal fourth quarter and full year fiscal 2026 ended June 30, 2026.

Revenue for the fourth quarter of fiscal 2026 was \$2.05 billion, with GAAP gross margin of 38.5% and GAAP net income of \$1.19 per diluted share. On a non-GAAP basis, gross margin was 40.2% with net income per diluted share of \$1.74.

“Fiscal 2026 was an outstanding year for Coherent, with record revenue, significant margin expansion, and non-GAAP EPS growth that was more than twice the rate of revenue growth,” said Jim Anderson, CEO. “We enter fiscal 2027 with exceptional customer demand, expanding production capacity, and multiple new growth platforms beginning to ramp. As AI datacenter architectures increasingly transition from copper to optical connectivity, we believe Coherent’s broad photonic technology portfolio and manufacturing scale uniquely position us to deliver accelerating growth and capitalize on this multi-year opportunity.”

Sherri Luther, CFO, said, “Strong operational execution across our business drove meaningful gross margin expansion and converted our top-line revenue growth into robust GAAP and non-GAAP EPS growth. As we enter fiscal 2027, we remain disciplined in our capital allocation, prioritizing investments to expand manufacturing capacity so we can efficiently fulfill the ongoing acceleration in customer demand.”

- (2) The Company has disclosed financial measurements in this earnings release that present financial information that are considered to be non-GAAP financial measures. These measurements are not a substitute for GAAP measurements, although the Company's management uses these measurements as an aid in monitoring the Company's on-going financial performance. The non-GAAP net earnings attributable to Coherent Corp., the non-GAAP diluted earnings per share, the non-GAAP operating income, the non-GAAP gross margin, the non-GAAP research and development, the non-GAAP selling, general and administrative expenses, the non-GAAP operating expenses, the non-GAAP interest and other (income) expense, and the non-GAAP income taxes, measure earnings and operating income (loss), respectively, excluding non-recurring or unusual items that are considered by management to be outside the Company's standard operation and excluding certain non-cash items. There are limitations associated with the use of non-GAAP financial measures, including that such measures may not be entirely

comparable to similarly titled measures used by other companies, due to potential differences among calculation methodologies. Thus, there can be no assurance whether (i) items excluded from the non-GAAP financial measures will occur in the future or (ii) there will be cash costs associated with items excluded from the non-GAAP financial measures. The Company compensates for these limitations by using these non-GAAP financial measures as supplements to GAAP financial measures and by providing the reconciliations of the non-GAAP financial measures to their most comparable GAAP financial measures. Investors should consider adjusted measures in addition to, and not as a substitute for, or superior to, financial performance measures prepared in accordance with GAAP. All non-GAAP amounts exclude certain adjustments for share-based compensation, acquired intangible amortization expense, restructuring charges (recoveries), impairments of assets held-for-sale, gains on sale of business, integration and site consolidation expenses, integration transaction expenses, and various one-time adjustments. Business Outlook – First Quarter Fiscal 2027⁽¹⁾

- Revenue for the first quarter of fiscal 2027 is expected to be between \$2.2 billion and \$2.4 billion.
 - Gross margin percentage for the first quarter of fiscal 2027 is expected to be between 39.5% and 41.5% on a non-GAAP basis.
 - Total operating expenses for the first quarter of fiscal 2027 are expected to be between \$400 million and \$420 million on a non-GAAP basis.
 - Tax rate for the first quarter of fiscal 2027 is expected to be between 18% and 20% on a non-GAAP basis.
 - EPS for the first quarter of fiscal 2027 is expected to be between \$1.85 and \$2.05 on a non-GAAP basis.
- (1) The Company has not provided a quantitative reconciliation of forward-looking non-GAAP gross margin percentage, non-GAAP operating expenses, non-GAAP tax rate and non-GAAP earnings per share, because we cannot, without unreasonable efforts, forecast certain items required to develop comparable GAAP measures. These items include, without limitation, restructuring charges, integration, site consolidation and other expenses, foreign exchange gains (losses), and share based compensation expense. The variability of these items could significantly impact our future GAAP financial results and we believe that the inclusion of any such reconciliations would imply a degree of precision that could be confusing or misleading to investors.

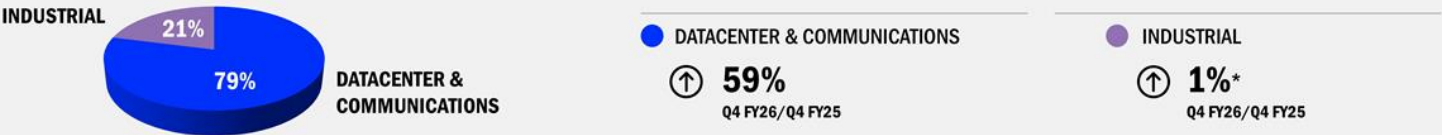

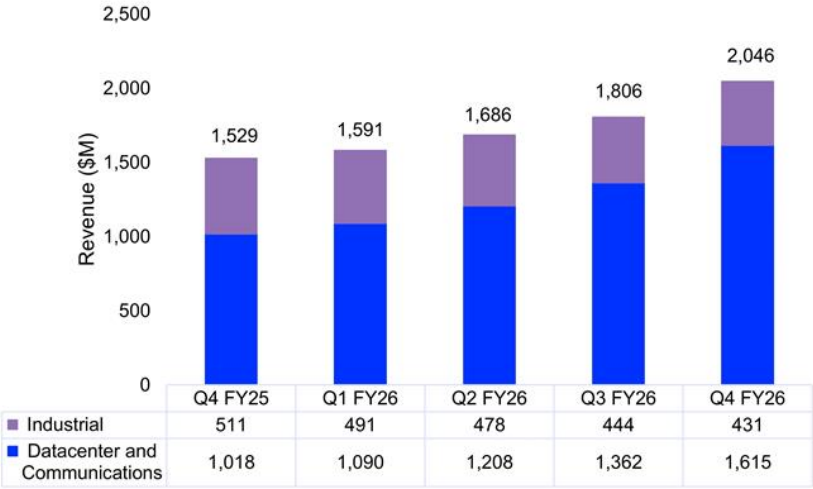
Revenue Mix Reflects Rapid Growth of Datacenter & Communications Segment*

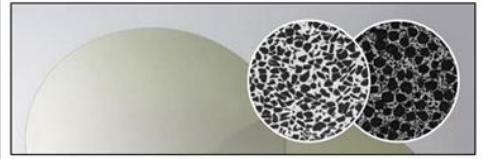

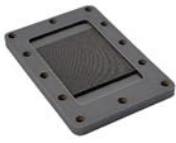
